- 1. Call to Order, Roll Call, Welcome, Introductions Darryl
 - a. Call to Order at 7:03pm
 - b. Attendees Darryl, Steve, Bill, Carol, Tony, Mark

- 2. Special Guests No Special Guests for April
- 3. Approval of Past Minutes: March 25, 2024
 - a. Minutes **APPROVED** (Move Steve / 2nd Tony All Voted Approval)

4. Treasurer's Report - Steve

- a. Checking balance \$17,943.05, savings balance \$1802.68.
- b. Since our last meeting we paid \$75 for our League of American Bicyclists' membership.
- c. We earned another \$0.05 in interest.
- d. Other balances are unchanged: \$250 worth of inventory (dew rags, Bicycle Benefits and Bicycle Friendly America materials), and the checking account holds \$882.66 for the AARP grant for Greenway System signage and \$13,895.38 in the Kyle Stiegert memorial fund).
- e. Our net worth is now \$5217.69.
- f. We are coming into the period during which we pay our membership fees to the Chamber and the Bike Fed. We will likely be paying \$50 BFB application fees for Summit Credit Union and Seminole Tap, but not Promega, before the next deadline of June 5. We are also looking at \$50 each for BFB award plaques for Avante, Chocolate Shoppe, and Rutabaga in the next month or so. Saris is a renewal and doesn't get a new plaque.

b. Greenway System / Update & Re-Ratify the Bike/Ped Plan - Steve

- i. Steve met Dawn at the Kyle Stiegert site. Ideas for a workday. Now meeting with Parks Maintenance and Management and the Fire Department.
 - 1. Looking to create a natural prairie which will require a burn which requires a fire break.
 - 2. Steve took the mayor on a BCycle ride to review site.
- **ii.** Greenway Project is working its way through the "Open Parks & Space Plan" update process. Steve provided many inputs to the author of the plan update.

i. Nothing new this month

d. Bike Rodeos / Education & Outreach - Mike / MarkW

- i. Activity Since Last Board Meeting
 - 1. Allied Neighborhood Bike Giveaway ~65 Bikes + helmets provided to neighborhood children. Mike held a 4-station rodeo assisted by Mark H & Mark W. In a different area of the park, Carol was busy teaching kids how to ride.
 - a. Discussion on photos taken and what do we do with them to help with marketing. Encourage posting either on BF Facebook or on personal stream with <u>TAG</u> for Bike Fitchburg.
 - 2. Teaching Safe Bicycling Class Hosted by Wisconsin Fed (+) DOT was attended by Mark W. along with 8 additional attendees, a couple of which are attending our LCI Training Sessions. After an informative classroom session, we broke into teams to set up a 6-station rodeo and walked the rest of the class through the station. Post discussion was held after each station with questions and suggestions for improvement.
 - 3. Smart Cycling Class Successfully held with 8 attendees. A great learning session with classroom, parking lot skills practice, and completing an 8-mile ride through the east side of Fitchburg to demonstrate the learnings from the day. A BIG THANK YOU

To Jon Rider and Steve Arnold who trained and facilitated this event. I am so looking forward to LCI on May 31st. One suggestion for BFB is to consider hosting this training annually.

6. Other Perpetual Topics

a. Fitchburg Bicycle Committee - Mark H

- i. As passed by the Fitchburg Common Council the "Fitchburg Bike Committee" will be rechristened as the "Fitchburg Bike and Pedestrian Commission" reporting to the Common Council.
 - 1. >10 meetings/year; Start reorg. in June
 - 2. >Add 2 new members with a focus on Pedestrian.
 - 3. >Will select a member to attend the Monthly Transportation and Transit Commission meeting to better link the groups.
- ii. Approval of 2 RRFD Lights; at Seminole Highway/Cannonball Trail and in Terravessa.
 - 1. Steve provided detailed information concerning these lights and the policy requirements that justify having new lights.
 - 2. Tony suggested we need to advocate for improvements for Badger State Trail where it crosses Seminole Rd. and where it crosses Whalen Rd. Lots of discussion but no specific action decided upon to move forward.
- iii. After Consultant selected in June, start the Refresh of the Bike/Ped. Plan
 - 1. The Bike Committee has completed its review and comments on the current plan.
 - 2. This will take the rest of 2024.

b. Policy & Public Works - Steve

- i. New side path on west end of Lacy Road / Wayfair in Stoner Prairie Neighborhood being worked 2024/2025. To be continued to the driveway of the school.
- ii. North side of McKee Rd from Fish Hatchery Rd to Seminole to get multi-use path.

- President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) into law on March 11, 2021. ARPA provides \$1.9 trillion in economic stimulus to aid the recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 2. The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) is investing some of its ARPA funding to implement a statewide grant program focused on addressing the epidemic of loneliness and isolation amongst older adults and people with disabilities.
