- 1. Call to Order, Roll Call, Welcome, Introductions Darryl
 - a. Call to Order at 7:04pm

2. Approval of Past Minutes: April 22, 2024

a. Minutes approved with no inputs for adjustments – Everyone in Favor.

3. Agenda Proposal - Mark

4. Treasurer's Report - Steve

- a. Checking balance \$17,210.81, savings balance \$1802.72.
- b. Since our last meeting we paid \$60 for Bicycle Benefits start-up kits, \$102.26 for 50 spike anchors for bike parking, and \$459.80 for 6 Bicycle Friendly Business plaques for new awardees. We received \$30 from Seminole Tap for one of the Bicycle Benefits start-up kits.
- c. We earned another \$0.04 in interest.
- d. Inventory increased to \$280 (dew rags, Bicycle Benefits and Bicycle Friendly America materials) due to an additional Bicycle Benefits start-up kit in stock.
- e. Other balances are unchanged: the checking account holds \$882.66 for the AARP grant for Greenway System signage and \$13,895.38 in the Kyle Stiegert memorial fund).
- f. Our net worth is now \$4545.49. (Adjusted from Steve's original email per discussion update)
- g. We are coming into the period during which we pay our membership fees to the Chamber and the Bike Fed. We will likely be paying \$50 BFB application fees for Summit Credit Union and Seminole Tap, but not Promega, before the next deadline of 6/5. Bicycle Friendly Business application fees and awards are among our largest expenses, but we are now tenth in the nation. Should we continue to pay for application fees and awards?
 - i. Motion to extend authorization for paying the Bicycle Friendly Business \$50/\$50
 mini grants for the next year (June / Oct / Winter) >> APPROVED. 8 For / 0 Against

- ii. The mini grants make it easier for a business to participate. IE: Managers may have to go through an extended process to get approval and then must determine in which budget category to apply the funds.
- h. Dew rags are still available for \$25. Let's move that inventory!
 - i. 2 dew rags sold during our meeting this month.

c. Better-Connected Trail System - Steve

- i. Steve is in the process of riding all the paths and streets in Fitchburg. (~280 miles / ~60% complete). He reported on several infrastructure issues that he found and submitted to the city for correction.
- ii. TTC (Transportation & Transit Commission) federal grant suggestions has agreed to apply for planning grants to get projects shovel ready.
 - 1. Examples are the creation of a multiuse path to the Village of Oregon and creation of a Boardwalk from Cap City Trail to Post Road over the eway.

d. Bike Rodeos / Education & Outreach - Mike

- i. Mike is meeting with Amanda from Tri4 Schools to negotiate using their bike trailer and parking lot to hold training.
- ii. **Action Item >>** Mike to send rodeo & table event dates for publishing into Event Calendar.
- iii. Mark to start attending <u>Greater Madison Bike Partners</u> meeting (MPO) with Steve to be able to attend as backup so we have full coverage.
- iv. Possible use of money for education banners / flags / better organization of literature.
- LCI League Cycling Instructor. As part of an effort to help Fitchburg achieve GOLD status, we are holding <u>1 of only 10 seminars</u> being offered in the USA. Darryl and Mark are attending.

e. Fitchburg Bicycle & Pedestrian Commission – Steve for Mark H

- i. Ordinance passed to officially change Fitchburg Bicycle Committee to the new Fitchburg Bicycle & Pedestrian Commission.
 - 1. Chamber member is now a nonvoting member.
 - 2. Added a new citizen member to recruit advocates for walking.
 - 3. 6 meeting per year upgraded to 10 meetings per year.

f. Policy & Public Works - Steve

- i. Fitchrona to Nesbitt Round About construction will include improved bicycle infrastructure.
- ii. Whalen Road shoulder work is in design.

Opportunities Heard

- Benefits of deeper dive on topics...
- Increase board & public education opportunities more people to help if they understand the "next layer" of the topic.
 - Bike Friendly Business
 - Cycling Without Age
 - Rodeos
- Better planning provides action items which Increase community involvement.
 - Incorporate some subcommittee work into a board meeting.
- Improve overall effectiveness of people's time commitments (Both Board + subcommittee time)
 - Everyone is busy. It is difficult to get subcommittee meetings scheduled. Especially during peak riding season.
 - Some topics better lend themselves to subcommittee. IE: Cycling Without Age is a topic so large that there is no way to cover the details in a board meeting.

How can we achieve this ??

- We get good board meeting attendance. Kudos for participation to the team!
- This is a work in progress it will evolve as we learn.
- Improve overall board meeting effectiveness.
 - Focus on decision making and work that makes a difference.
 - Allow for monthly "Deep Dive" topics.
 - Reduce update frequency on topics that do not need to be automatically on the agenda each month.
 - IE: Data / Metrics / Routing Updates can be viewed outside the meeting and questions or concerns can be handled.
 - Creation of Future Agenda Topics Calendar based upon priority / annual cycle of events.
 - Example: Feb/March focus on Bike Week Events
 - Planning for our routine events that we host / support is predictable.
 - Rotation on some perpetual topics while allowing for help needed or significant updates to be requested for upcoming agenda.
 - Require agenda request to board secretary before the Friday EOB prior to the next board meeting.
 - Put prioritized topics toward the top of the agenda.
 - Special Guests
 - New Business
 - Bike Fitchburg primary focus programs.
 - Topics that require a decision / vote
