1. Call to Order, Roll Call, Welcome, Introductions - Darryl

2. Approval of Past Minutes for Oct 28, 2024

- a. Minutes approved with no corrections
- 3. Treasurer's Report Steve (as of 11/25/2025)
 - a. Checking \$17,442.70; savings balance \$1803.00
 - b. Since our last meeting we paid \$50 each to Thad, Carol, and Pam for driving in support of ¡Pick Me Up Me Up at the Border! 2024, and \$200 to the Bike League for Bicycle Friendly Business sign artwork so we can procure our own BFB signs from a local vendor. Pam donated her \$50 back to Bike Fitchburg. (Thanks, Pam!)
 - c. We received \$541.29 in contributions to the Kyle Stiegert Memorial fund and an unrestricted donation of \$500 from Dennis M Levy, a Fitchburg resident previously unknown to me. (Thanks, Dennis!) Derek Wolff of the Rusty Bee Lounge reimbursed us \$50 for his BFB application fee.
 - d. We earned another \$0.05 in interest.
 - e. There were no changes to the inventory, which is valued at \$155 and includes dew rags and Bicycle Benefits materials.
 - f. Other balances are changed as follows. The checking account holds:
 - i. \$882.66 from the AARP grant for Greenway System signage (unchanged),
 - ii. \$13,825.68 in the Kyle Stiegert memorial fund (increased), and iii. \$234.96 in the Cycling Without Age fund (unchanged).
 - g. Our net worth is now \$4407.40.
 - h. Anticipated future financial activity includes reimbursement for one \$50 BFB fee, posting of an outstanding check for \$50, a deposit of \$700 less fees for the Stiegert memorial via PayPal, and the cost of five BFB award plaques.

5. Traffic Counter

- d. Proposal for Bike Fitchburg to pay for the subscription so we can access the data and manage the analysis.
- e. Recruit other people such as Bicycle Friendly Businesses to install counters at their business location.
- f. Concern expressed that if BF subscribes and then wants to transfer that expense to the city it might be a problem.
